HJAVS 2011 SHOW SCHEDULE

HORTICULTURE DIVISION – RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Only HJAVS members in good standing are eligible to enter exhibits.
2. Only clean, healthy, pest-free show plants which have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least 3 months will be accepted.
3. Plants must be correctly named or they will be subject to correction by the Classification Committee or the show Chairman.
4. All standard African Violets must be slip-potted. Self watering pots such as Moist-rite and Oyama may be entered as is. Trailers and Other Gesneriads may be exhibited in the container in which they are growing. Show plants must not leave any dirt or debris on the show table. Section 2 plants (minis and semis) are encouraged to be in a decorative reservoir situation. Otherwise they dry out too much during the show.
5. Rings will be allowed for this show. Other supports and training devices will only be allowed on the Other Gesneriads.
6. An exhibitor may enter only 1 plant of each **variety** in each Section. Another plant of the same variety may be entered in another Section (e.g. Unusual container).
7. All plants in Sections 1, 2, 5 and 6 should be single crowned plants.
8. Gesneriads other than African Violets may be exhibited in protective containers, such as a domed pot, and natural colored mulch may be used on the soil surface.
9. A list of your show entries must be given to Carol Hixenbaugh no later than 3/20/2011. You must include the following information:
 - Full name of plant
 - Section in which plant belongs
 - Sale price, if it will be for sale (or indicate if it will NOT be for sale)Carol will create name tags and an entry sheet for your show plants. You may scratch plants off of your list up until 9am Friday morning, March 25, 2011.
10. Show plants must be at the show by 3 PM Thursday, March 24, 2011.
11. Entries not sold must be picked up by the owner (or by other arrangement) no later than 5 PM Saturday, March 26, 2011.
12. Section 2 plants(minis and semis) are encouraged to be in a decorative reservoir situation. Otherwise, they dry out too much during the show.
